

Notice of Proposal to Adopt Regulation

The Department of Economic Development and Commerce (“DEDC”) is currently in the process of adopting new regulation, “Reglamento para Incentivos por Promoción bajo el Fondo Especial para el Desarrollo de la Exportación de Servicios y Promoción”.

The purpose of the proposed regulation is to establish the rules related to the disbursement of moneys derived from the Special Fund for the Development of Services for Export and Promotion, in order to encourage the involvement and engagement of individuals in the promotion of Puerto Rico as a business destination for the exportation of services. The approval of the proposed regulation is pursuant to Act 170 of August 12, 1988, as amended, known as “Ley de Procedimiento Administrativo Uniforme”; and of the powers conferred to the Secretary of Economic Development and Commerce, by Art. 4 of the Reorganization Plan No. 4 of 1994 (3 L.P.R.A. Ap. X sec. III).

Any individual interested in commenting on the proposed regulation may do so by sending such comments by email to jannette.gonzalez@ddec.pr.gov or by mail to PO Box 362350, San Juan, P.R. 00918 in attention to the Secretary Office of the DEDC, within the next 30 calendar days from the publishing of this notice. During the same term, and in the manner stated above, any individual may also request in writing an oral hearing regarding the proposed regulation. Said request shall include the arguments that, according to the petitioner, make an oral hearing necessary.
